

## TAB (TABLATURE)

**Tab** is a popular way of writing guitar music down on paper.

It is made up of 6 lines and each line represents a string on the guitar - E, A, D, G, B, e.

Thinnest & highest sounding string

**e**

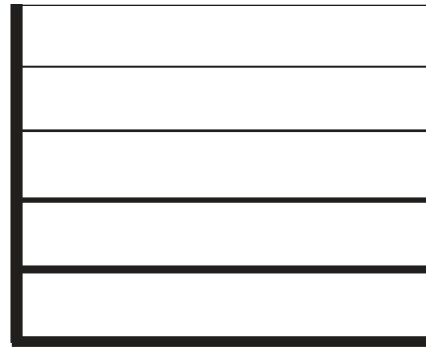
**B**

**G**

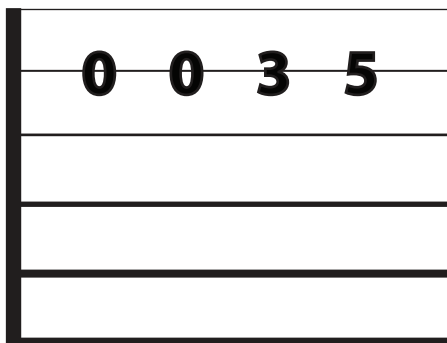

Thickest & lowest sounding string



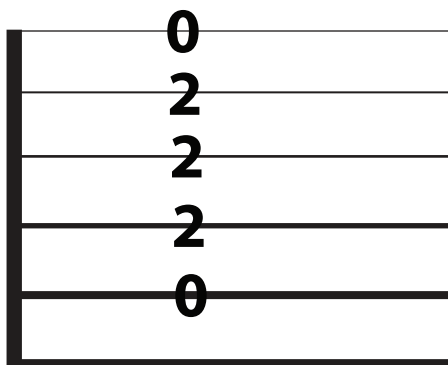
The numbers show you which fret you will be playing. In this example it will be -

**open string / open string / 3rd fret / 5th fret**

The numbers are placed on the line which indicates which string you will be playing. In this example you will be playing -

**B string**

When the numbers are shown next to each other it means the notes will be played one after the other.



When there are numbers on top of each other this means that the notes will be played at the same time. A chord.

In this example the TAB shows an -

**A Major**
